SHIHAN KYLE HAYES

Sensei Hayes has been training in the Bujinkan Dojo for more than 27 years and has almost 30 years of experience in the martial arts. Sensei has studied various other arts before finding his home and settling on the methods of the Bujinkan Dojo.

Sensei Hayes has been teaching the art for the last 25 years. He earned the title of “Shidoshi” (Teacher of the Warrior Ways) in 1995 when he passed the Godan (5th Degree Black Belt) Test under his direct teacher and now Sempai, Robert Johnson, “Shihan” (Master Instructor), Jugodan (15th Degree Black Belt) of the Bujinkan Indianapolis Dojo.

Sensei Hayes is currently a Jugodan (15th Degree Black Belt) in the Bujinkan Dojo and is a member of the International Bujinkan Dojo Organization and Shidoshi-Kai (Instructors Guild) headed by Dr. Masaaki Hatsumi the “Soke” (Grandmaster) of the tradition. Sensei Hayes takes his direction from Hatsumi Sensei and Johnson Sensei directly. Sensei Hayes typically travels to Japan at least annually with Johnson Sensei to train with Hatsumi Sensei and the other Shihan.
